

Application Package

Thank you for expressing interest in the Psychologist position recently advertised by Gladstone State High School. The successful applicant will be engaged on a temporary basis 36.25 hours per week. The temporary engagement will be from 10 July to 8 December 2017 with possibility of extension. Following is information on this position.

Place of engagement

The successful applicant will be required to work as a temporary Psychologist at Gladstone State High School, 30 Dawson Road, GLADSTONE.

Hours of Duty

The successful applicant will be engaged for 7.25 hours per day, 5 days a week. Start and finish times will be between 7.30am and 5.00pm.

Wage rate

The successful applicant will be appointed to P02 Classification; salary is between \$57143 - \$73139 per annum. The wage rate will vary if the successful applicant is an existing employee on another pay point level. To view the current salary schedule visit:

ADO arrangements

In addition to your 36.25 hours per week, you may be required to accrue ADO to cover the vacation period. You will be required to sign an ADO agreement which will have a schedule indicating the number of days you have elected to take and when the additional hours are to be worked.

Leave arrangements

The successful applicants will accrue recreation leave at the rate of 20 days per annum and sick leave at the rate of 10 days per annum (cumulative) from the date of appointment.

Mandatory Conditions

Possession of a degree in Psychology from a recognised tertiary institution or other equivalent formal qualifications which, in the opinion of the Director-General of the department or delegate, are acceptable.

Full registration as a Psychologist through the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA) Psychology Board or a fourth year qualification in Psychology that will enable general registration as a Psychologist through the AHPRA Psychology Board following completion of the board approved internship or accredited sequence of study.

The *Child Protection Reform Amendment Act 2014* requires the preferred applicant to be subject to a working with children check as part of the employment screening process.



The department is legally obliged to warn applicants that it is an offence for a disqualified person to sign a blue card application form. Further details regarding the blue card system is available at: www.bluecard.qld.gov.au/

Confirmation of employment is conditional upon the preferred applicant being issued with a Blue Card from the Public Safety Business Agency (PSBA).

A criminal history check will be initiated on the successful applicant by the Queensland Police Service.

Furthermore, the successful applicant may be subject to a probation period of up to a maximum of six months. In determining the probation period to be applied, prior service with the Department may be taken into account.

Applications

Applicants are required to submit a detailed resume which includes contact details for 2 referees (one of whom is your current supervisor), certified copies of their Degree in Psychology and proof of current registration with AHPRA Psychology Board. A maximum 3 page written response outlining your suitability for the role under "How you will be assessed" must be included to be considered for this position.
