## BYOD

All students attending Gladstone SHS in 2022, are encouraged to bring a device to school. The device will be used to enhance curriculum delivery, to enable online research and for work production, creation and submission. Connection to the internet will be provided via the school network. As a school, we are transitioning towards a single device in 2022, where Year 7 students enrolling in 2022 will be required to bring an iPad. As such, we would encourage families to consider an iPad when/if they intend on purchasing a device for 2022 (Students currently enrolled with a windows/Mac device will be able to continue using their device in 2022).
